This contest is designed to promote Jeju brand values such as the beautiful scenery, culture, and people of UNESCO triple crown Jeju internationally

A. Eligibility

- Open to Koreans and those of any nationality.

B. Theme

- Jeju Island

C. Requirement and How to submit

- 1) Please set your file names as below;
'submitter's name – your field / picture title (Place taken)'
e.g.) John Smith – Digital Camera / Beautiful Mountatins (Halla Mountain)
- 2) All kinds of photos are acceptable. Color, Black and White, Digital or Analog.
- 3) Number of works 3 minimum - 5 maximum.
- 4) In the case of series work, the set of pictures are considered as one piece of work. So the work should be submitted as one image.
- 5) Requirement

The work should be submitted as jpg file less than 3MB in 300dpi regardless of photo type. (Digital, Film and Mobile all accepted)

*Original files are required only for the 'FINAL ROUND' entrants

In case of drone photos, the information of location, elevation and time should be recognized in EXIF

- 6) Enter official website (www.jejucontest.com), press 'apply' to complete your application.

F. Prizes

Total 6,600,000 KRW (22 people)

Grand Prize (1): 2,000,000 KRW with a certificate of merit

Gold Prize (1): 1,000,000 KRW with a certificate of merit

Silver Prize (2): 600,000 KRW each with a certificate of merit

Bronze Prize (3): 300,000 KRW each with a certificate of merit

Fine Work Prize (15): 100,000 KRW each with a certificate of merit (Incl. tax)

H. Exclusion from selection and annulment of award decision

In the following cases, entries shall be excluded from selection or the award shall be canceled and could be accused of obstruction of business.

- The entry form is not completed and the entrant's information is not clearly written
- What is written in the entry form is different from what it really is.
- The work violates the rights of a third party, such as portrait and copyrights
- The entrant does not hold the copyright of the photo.
- The winning work has been awarded or selected at any other previous competition.
- The winning work is found to be a plagiarism of, or closely related to other works.
- The photo is artificially distorted by artificial intelligence or composite photo
- When the work is not photographed in accordance with the regulations
- The entrant does not submit original work over 5MB after passing selection
- Submitted original work does not matches the entry work
- Fail to submit requested documents by the executive office on time

-
- The entrant does not hold a legal drone-related approval from Korean government and take illegal photo. (Only drone-photos)
 - When the work is deemed unsuitable for examination criteria

I. Copyright / Portrait Right

- All rights of prize winning works - such as copyright, property right and the right of use etc. - belong to the entrants, and organizer could use the prize winning works to promote Jeju island in the purpose of public interest.
- If needed, organizer could partially take over the copyrights of the work or obtain permission to use them (for use other than public interest purpose) with the consultation of copyright holder separately.
- Entrants should resolve portrait rights and copyrights etc. of their works in advance, and if it is found to be awarded by fraudulent means, the award may be canceled, the prize money may be returned and legal punishment may be taken.
- Entrants who pass the screening may need to submit consent form of possible Copyright / Portrait Rights invasion additionally when organizer request for it.(Consent form will be sent to the entrants separately)
- Matters not mentioned in these regulations will be decided by the organizer.

<Caution>

- Works cannot be submitted in duplicate with other contests and there must be no plagiarism.
- Entrants are responsible for all disputes and legal issues, including copyright, right to use, portrait rights, plagiarism, etc. arising from the applied works.
- The award may be adjusted or not awarded depend on the number or quality of the work.
- The details of the examination shall not be open to the public, and objections to the composition of the judges, the criteria and results of examination shall not be raised.
- In case of drone photos, authorized drone request form should be submitted.

* Anyone who has submitted an application for entry to this contest shall be deemed to agree to all of the above.
